The four classically trained soloists will perform vocal and instrumental renditions of folk songs, ancient chants and pagan ritual songs, Church psalms in the folk-minstrel tradition, and choral pieces. In addition to a cappella singing, the ensemble plays an array of instruments, including violin, modern and classic bandura, accordion, hammer dulcimer, folk flute (sopilka), pan flute, bass sopilka, block-flute, bells, and others. Ensemble members have been affili-



ated with the National Philharmonic of Ukraine, the Tchaikovsky National Music Academy (former Kyiv Conservatory), and the Lviv Conservatory. They are on tour in the United States, with performances in New York, Boston, and Chicago. The Harvard concert is sponsored by the Harvard Ukrainian Summer Institute, a joint program of the Harvard Summer School and the Ukrainian Research Institute. Admission is free and open to the public.
