- ☐ For non-native English speakers: most recent TOEFL, IELTS, or PTE Academic score report. (Alternatively, submit a transcript that meets the requirements listed on the Summer School webpage for English proficiency requirements.) Scores must be no more than two years old and must be verifiable. Required scores to prove English proficiency are:
 - a minimum score of 100 on the Internet-based TOEFL
 - a minimum score of band 7.0 on the IELTS
 - a minimum score of 70 on the PTE Academic
- ☐ Scholarship application (if applicable) - by March 20 (May 1 for language)
 - Essay
 - College transcript (a copy issued to the student is acceptable)
 - Recommendation from a college instructor (or employer if you are out of school)
- ☐ If you are not applying for a scholarship: Brief cover letter introducing yourself and your interest in HUSI
